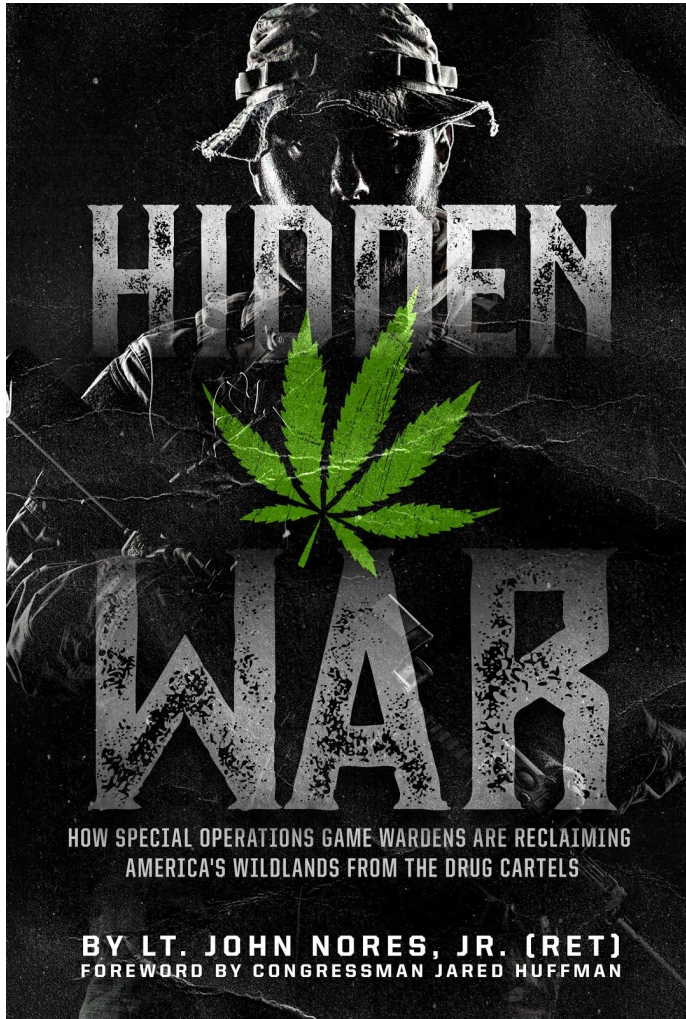


HIDDEN WAR
